- (2) Participant TINs in Medicare Shared Savings Program ACOs must be removed from the 2022 Participant List submitted to CMS by 9/10/2021 in order to serve as a DC Participant Provider in a DCE for PY2022.
- (3) KCC Participants must be removed from the final Participant Provider list submitted on 6/23/21 in order to serve as a DC Participant Provider in a DCE for PY2022.
- (4) PCF Cohort 1 practices must notify the PCF Model by 8/13/2021 if they intend to join a DCE for PY2022. To participate as a DC Participant Provider, the provider's PCF practice will be required to have a withdrawal date from PCF of 12/31/2021. Any provider affiliated with a DCE that wants to remain eligible to participate in PCF Cohort 2 must be removed from the 2022 DC Participant Provider list by 9/17/2021.
- (5) IAH practices must notify the IAH Demonstration and remove themselves from 2022 participation by 9/10/2021 if they intend to join a DCE for PY2022.
- (6) VTACO Participant Providers must be removed from the 2022 Participant List by 9/10/2021 if they intend to join a DCE for PY2022.
- (7) All providers located in Maryland are considered part of the Maryland Total Cost of Care Model and are not permitted to join GPDC.
