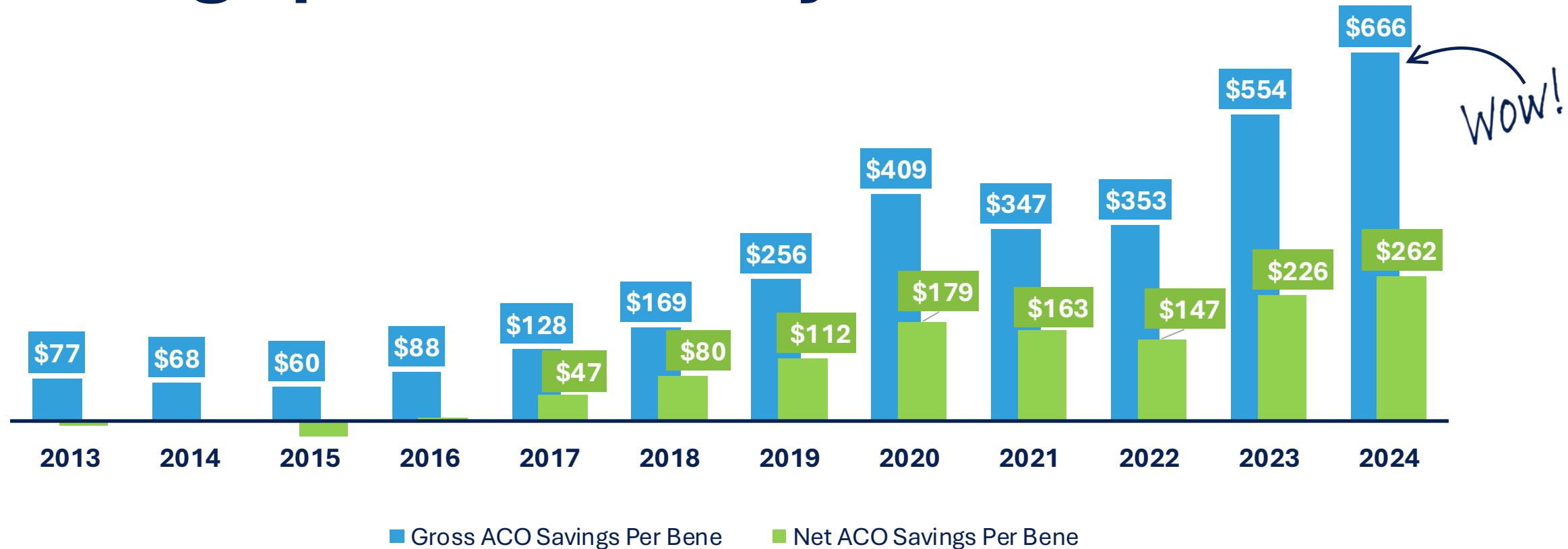
NAACOS members meet the moment

Through 2024 Medicare ACOs have generated **\$36.4B** in gross savings



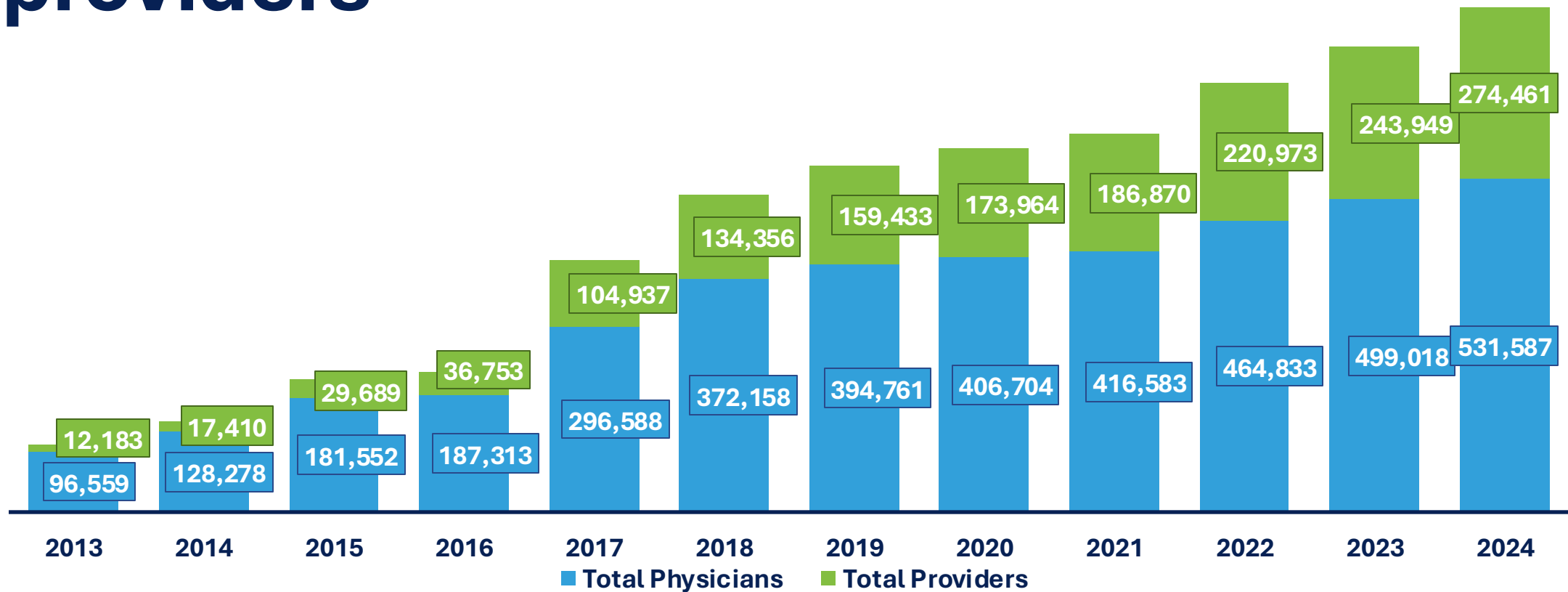

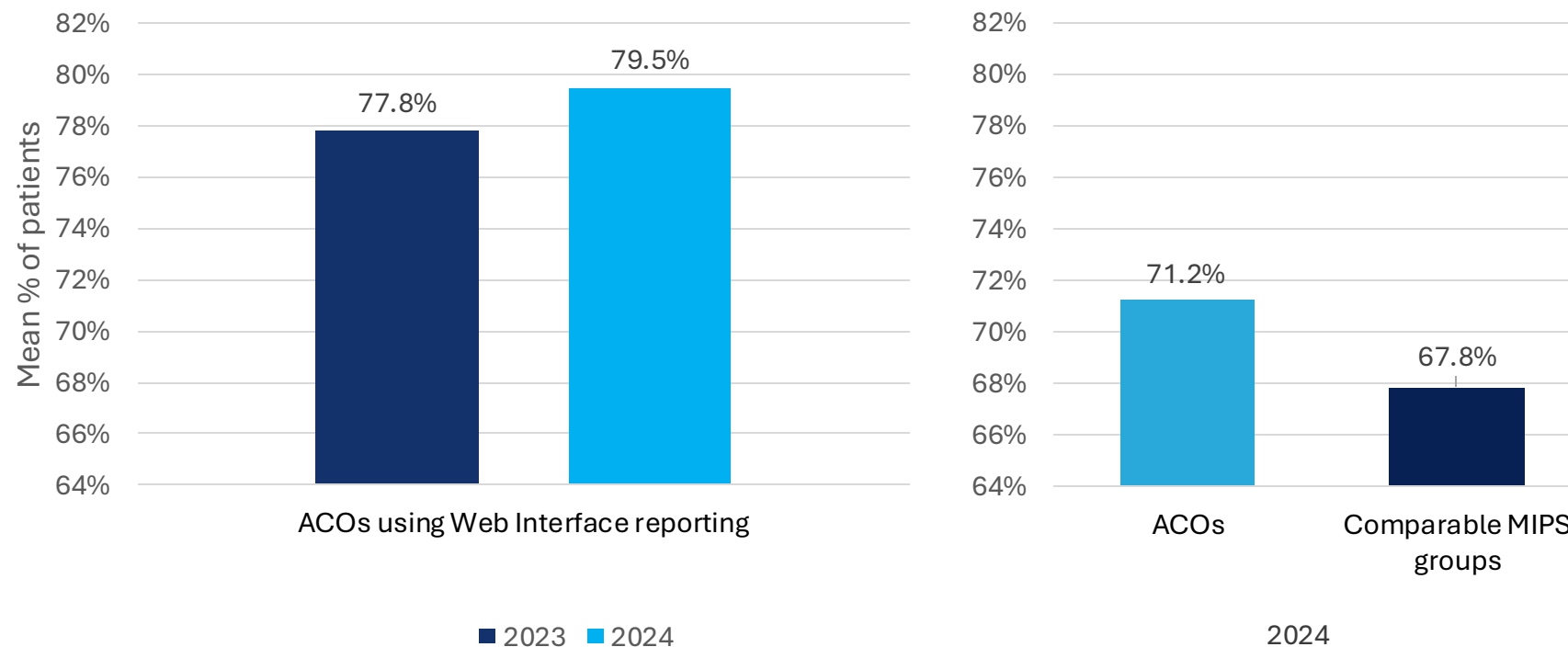

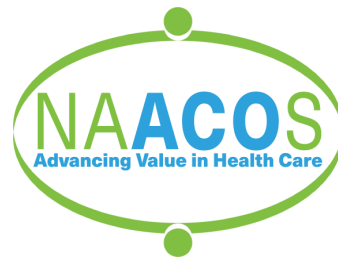

ACOs Continue to Improve & Outperform

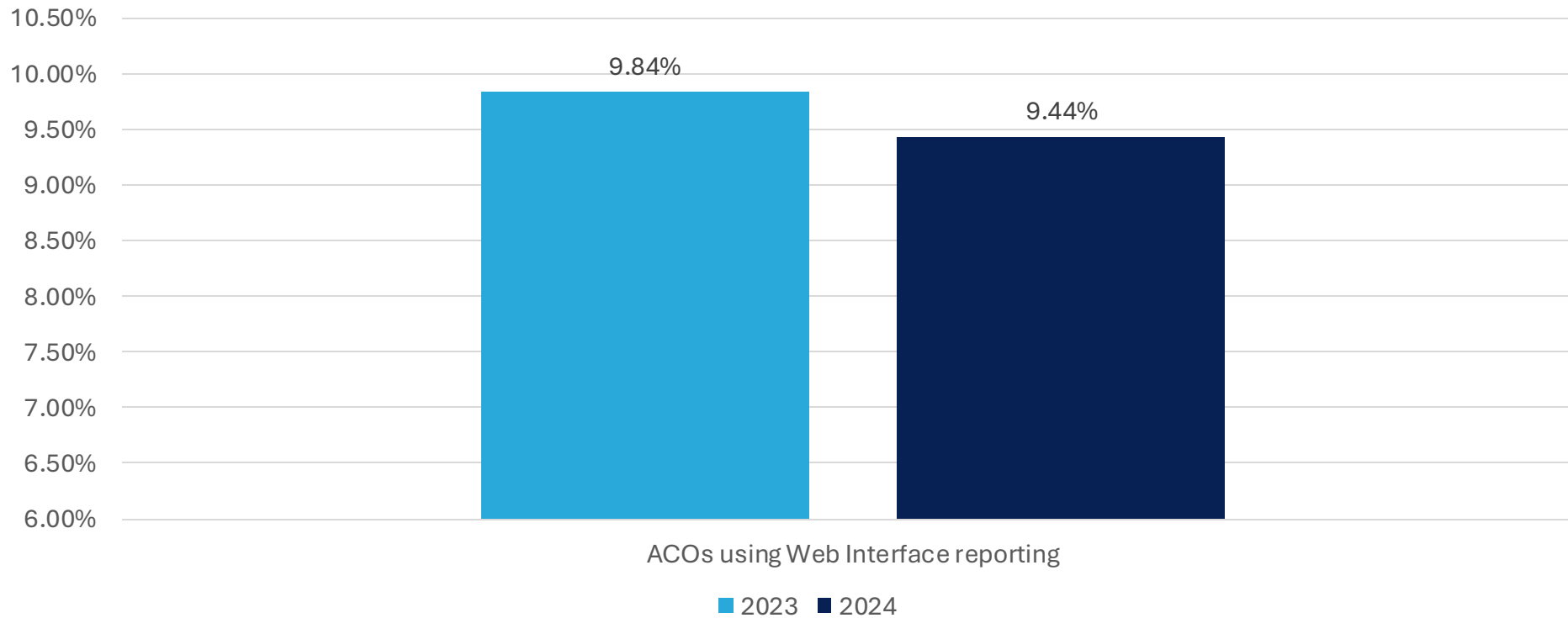
Average % of patients with controlled high blood pressure (higher is better)



ACOs Continue to Improve & Outperform

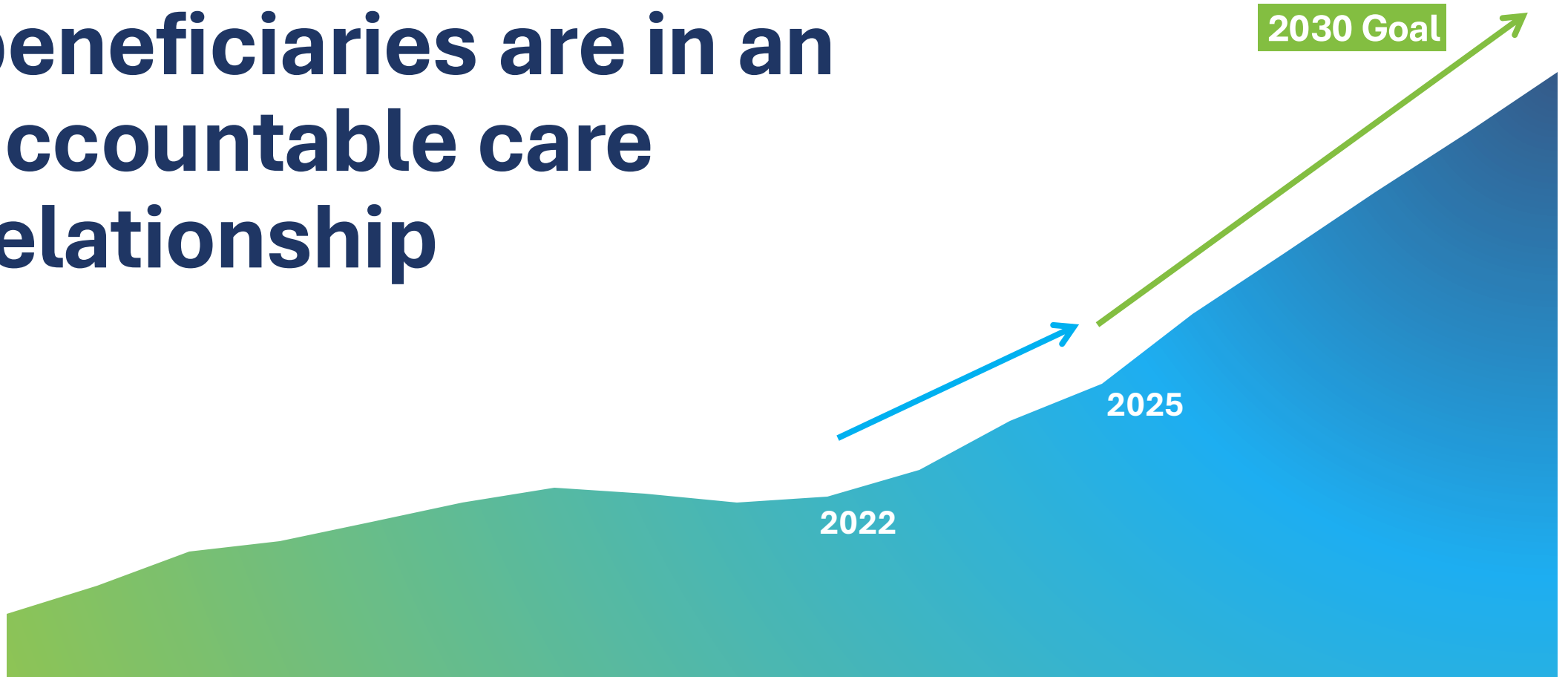


Average % of patients with poor A1C control declined significantly (lower is better)

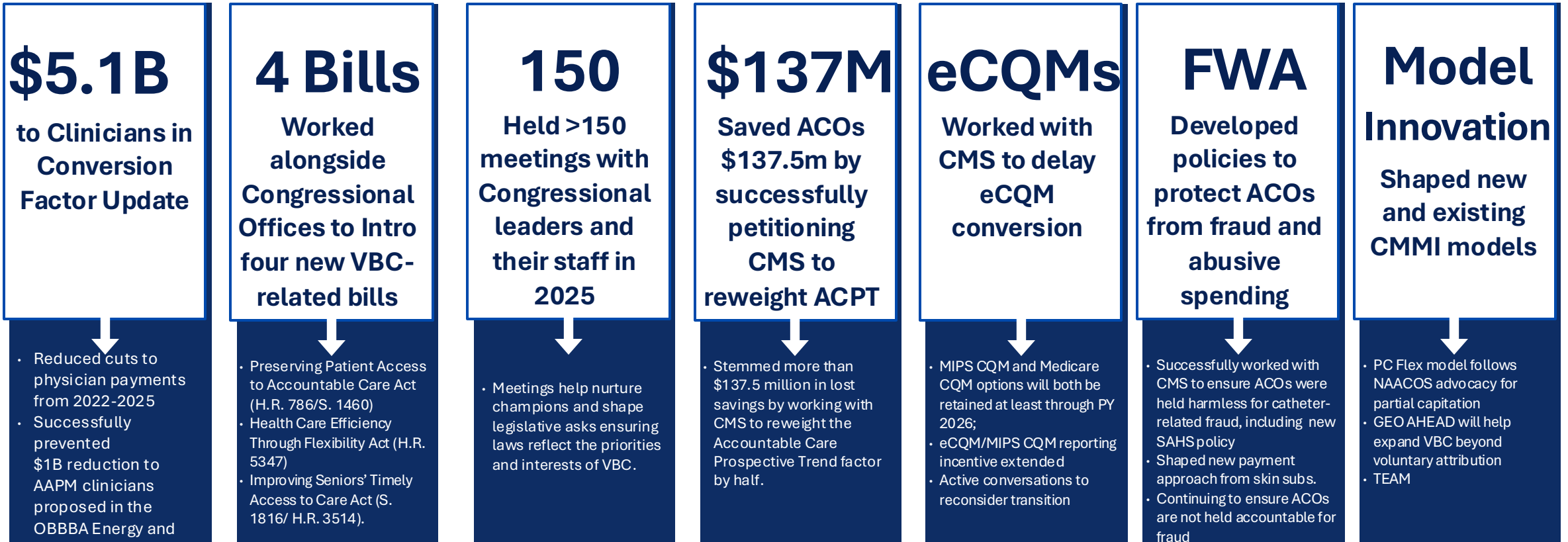

Today, **14.8M or 53.4%** of Traditional Medicare beneficiaries are in an accountable care relationship

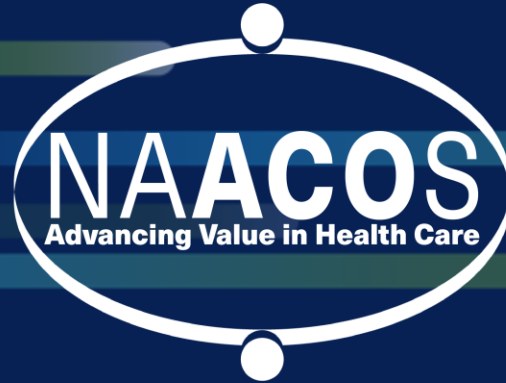


Advocacy Supports Impactful VBC
