

NAACOS Applauds Congress' Progress on Reducing ACO Reporting Burden
Statement from Emily Brower, president and CEO of the National Association of ACOs

The National Association of ACOs applauds House leadership for advancing the *Health Care Efficiency Through Flexibility Act* ([H.R. 5347](#)) through a suspension vote this week.

The bill would help ease burdensome quality reporting requirements by directing the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to pilot a new, more practical approach to digital quality reporting. This approach would align reporting mandates with accountable care organizations' efforts to improve the quality of care and reduce administrative costs, allowing physicians and other clinicians to put more resources back into patient care.

We appreciate the bipartisan Committee work and House leadership that has supported policies that reduce administrative burden for health care clinicians leading care transformation and caring for America's seniors.
