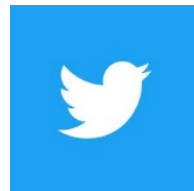

# New VP of Education



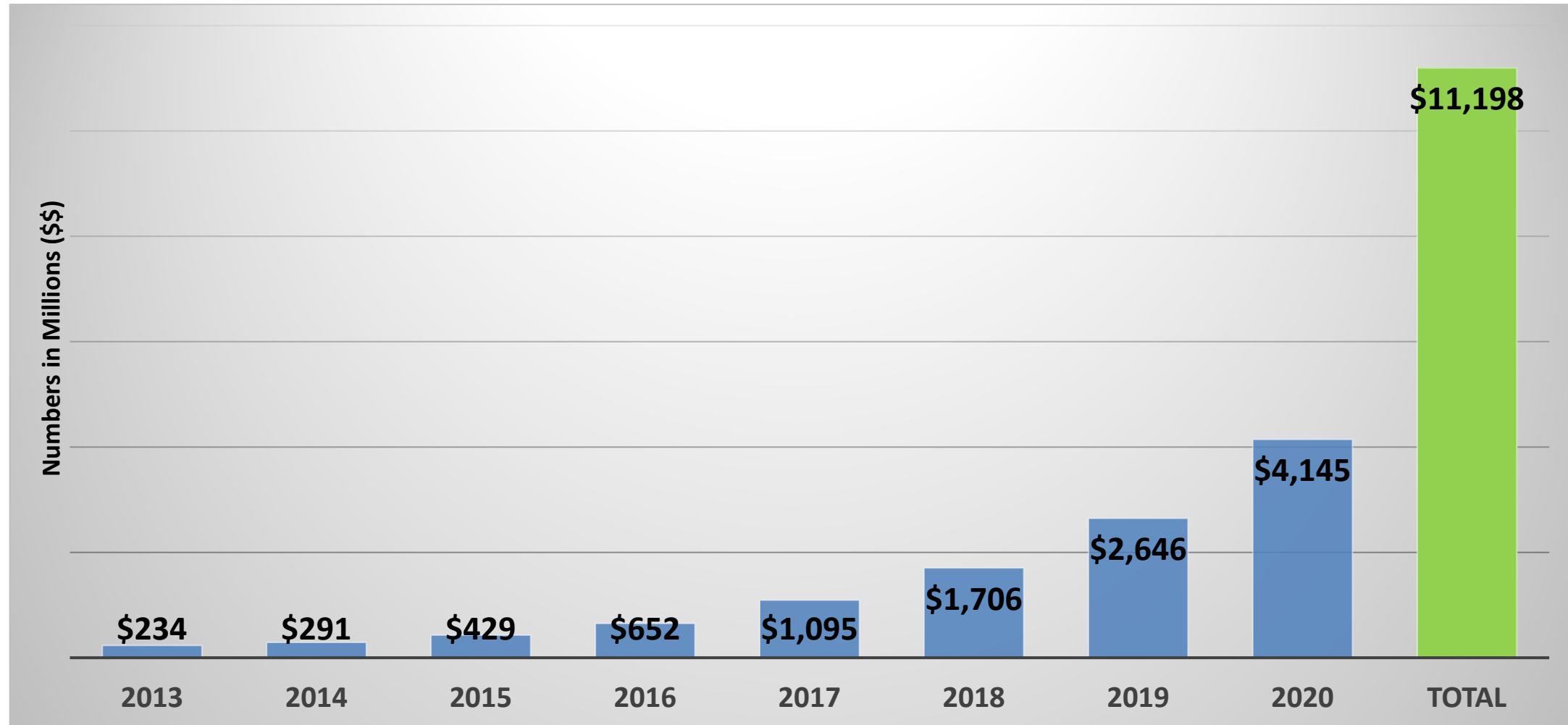

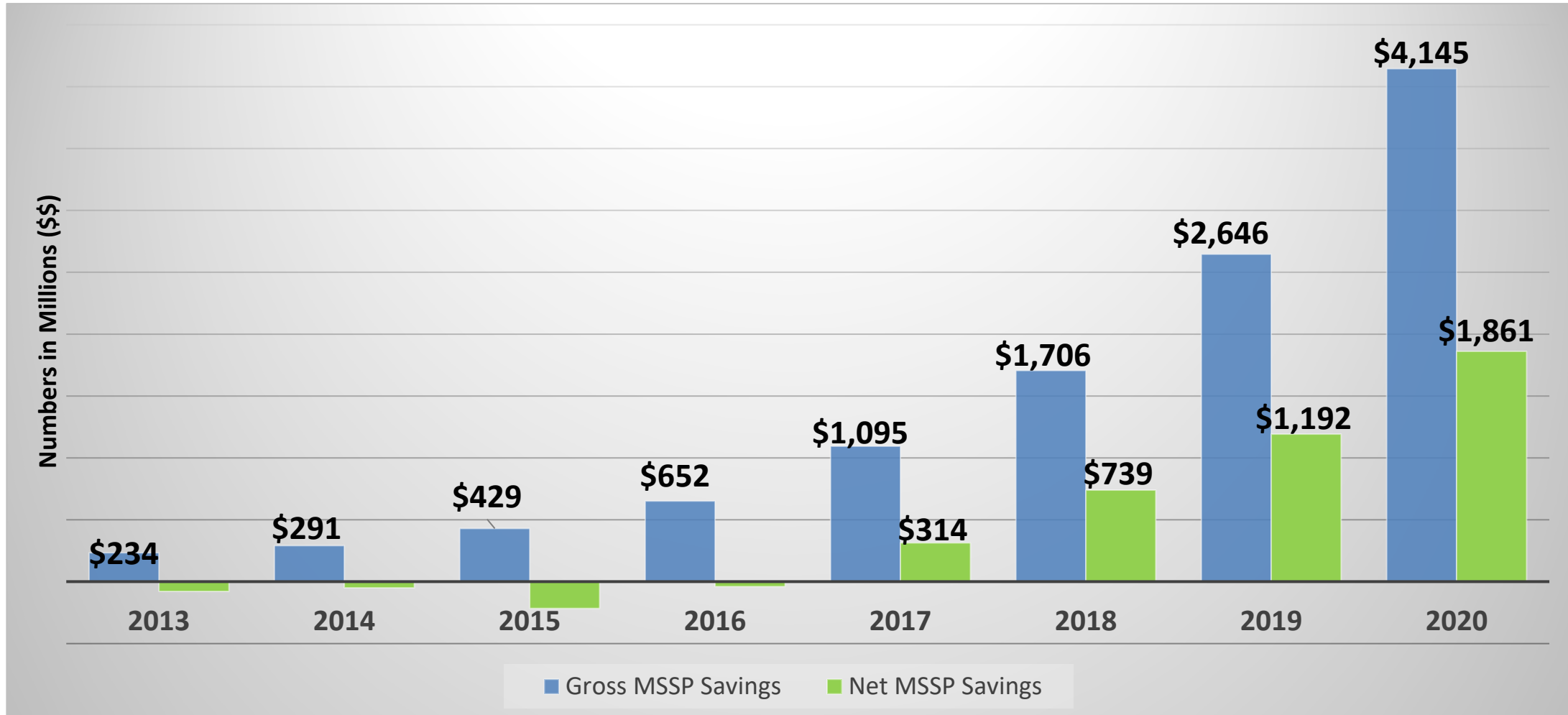
# Transition to Value remains strong

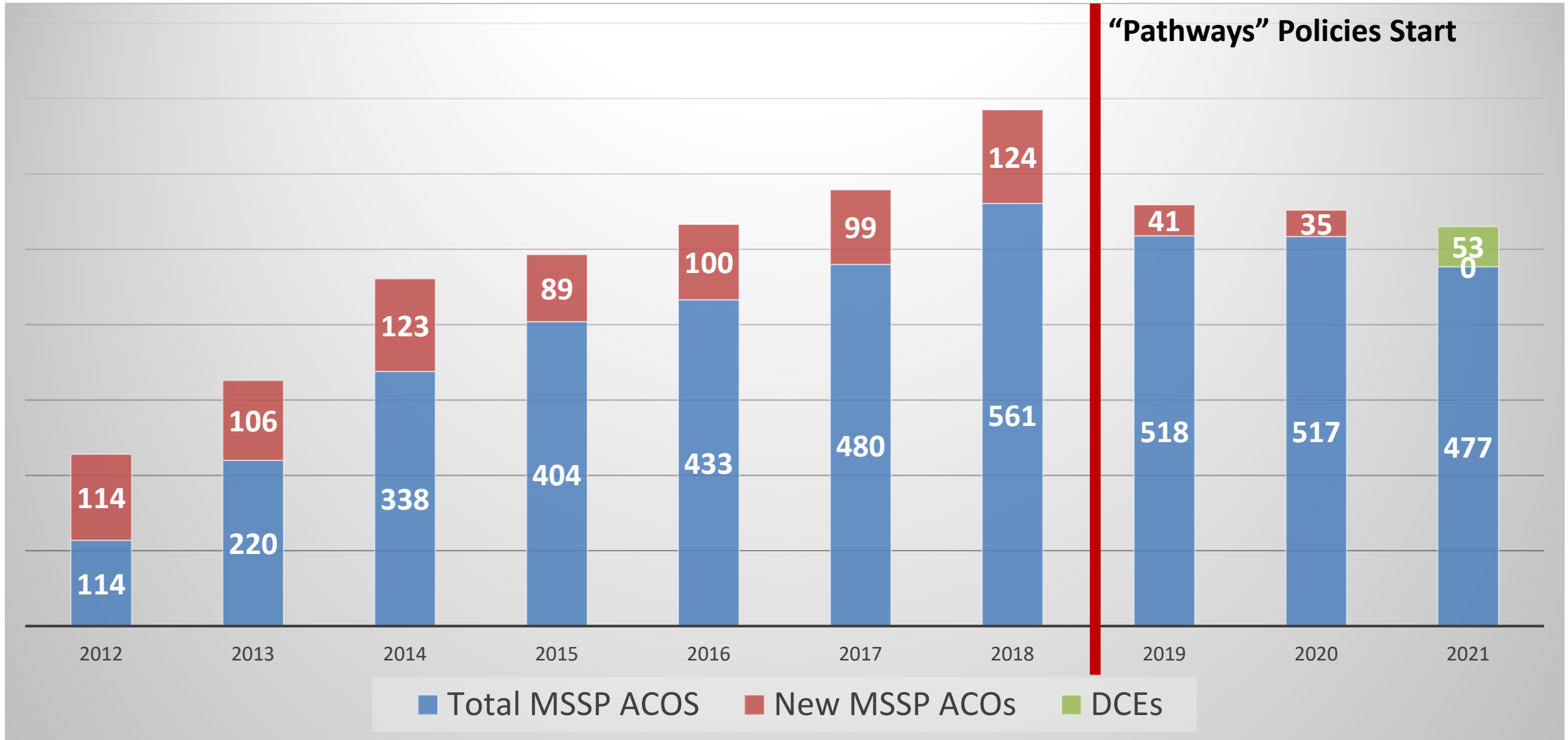
# Gross MSSP Savings.....

# How Do We Fix It?



- NAACOS is committed to working with all payers to support the transition to accountable care and population health.
- Set a national goal to have a majority of traditional Medicare beneficiaries in an ACO by 2025 and a majority of private payer contracts with VBP provisions
- Focus on delivery system transformation to achieve affordable, equitable and patient-centric healthcare for all Americans
- Strengthen primary care as the foundation for “whole person care” and deprioritize the emphasis on risk
- Strengthen incentives to attract new ACOs and retain existing ones
- Provide meaningful advanced funding to address the inequities in healthcare
- Ensure a meaningful role of quality in ACO programs and provide time to assess the feasibility of digital & electronic quality measures (eCQMs)
